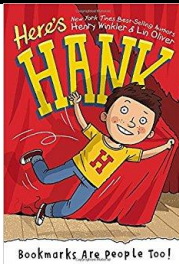
This program is designed for students with:

Two options are available:

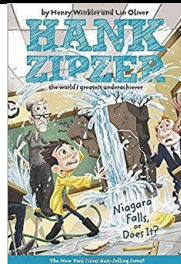
- Your child reads a pre-selected novel

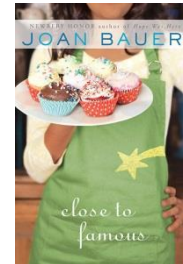
