



Keyboarding Without Tears (KWT)

Keyboarding Without Tears (KWT) from **Learning Without Tears®** is a web-based curriculum for grades K–5 that teaches typing, general computer readiness, digital citizenship and online test prep.

Promoted as a first step of digital learning, KWT teaches children the skills they will need to type fluently, learn computer functions, format text and discover how to interact in many online environments. Each program is based on the child's current grade level in order to establish a solid foundation for inexperienced students, but also allows students to accelerate at a faster pace once they have mastered a skill.

One C&FD Educational Specialist, **Marie Arrington MAT NBCT**, is certified in KWT.

KWT is a fun, engaging typing program that does not take much time out of your family and child's already busy day! Marie keeps track of your child's progress within the KWT program and uses the data to keep you informed and provide your child with continued feedback. KWT teaches your child an essential life skill that they will use throughout their life!

KWT is a complement to Handwriting Without Tears (HWT), a multi-sensory approach to posture, strength, grasp, coordination, perception and writing. C&FD educators and occupational therapists offer individual and group HWT services.

Cost

Individual sessions are offered at \$65 per hour or \$37.50 per half-hour. These sessions are not billable to insurance.

Materials

KWT access and materials are required and are available on their website (www.lwtears.com). The educator will inform each family as to what product is needed for their child. Families purchase access to the program and use the log-in information at every session. Each license costs \$10.
