Child & Family Development provides therapy in the aquatic medium at the **James J. Harris Family Branch YMCA** at 5900 Quail Hollow Road, Charlotte, NC, 28210 (704.716.6800).

Child & Family Development (C&FD) and YMCA Therapy Rules:

1. Pool sessions are offered in blocks. Usual and customary blocks are defined as spring, summer and fall. I agree to pay a \$25.00 program fee for each block of pool sessions. Fees must be paid prior to first session of a block to the Client Services team.
 - a. Clients seen in the water without a permanent appointment or only on a cancellation basis agree to pay an annual \$25.00 program fee. If you transition to a permanent appointment for any block, a \$25.00 fee per block is required.
2. A caregiver must be nearby and observing the session at all times.
3. Upon advanced request from the C&FD therapist, a caregiver will accompany the child into the water.
4. From time to time, pool-based sessions are not available. During these times, services may be offered in the clinic. Examples include: severe weather (the therapist may be able to see your child on the YMCA premises), clinical recommendation, medical contraindications and individual therapist break/leave/exit. Program fee refunds are not available.

YMCA Rules:

1. C&FD therapists, clients and caregivers will follow all rules posted in the YMCA building and pool areas.
2. C&FD therapists, clients and caregivers will follow the instruction of YMCA personnel.
3. Severe Weather: If lightning is detected in the vicinity of the pool, both indoor and outdoor will be evacuated for a time no less than 30 minutes after the last sign of lightning or thunder.
4. Contamination: In the event of a bodily fluid contamination of the pool, that pool will be evacuated and the appropriate measures will be taken. This may cause the pool to remain closed for up to 6 hours.
5. Showers must be taken before entering the pool.
6. Bathing suits are required. No gym shorts, cut-offs, or street clothes are allowed.
7. Non-swimmers and children must be kept within arms reach of a caregiver at all times.
8. Swimmers who are not toilet trained must wear appropriate swim diapers with elastic pants.

I assume full responsibility for risk of bodily injury, death or property damage. I have read and agree to adhere to the rules stated above. I am responsible for informing and requiring all caregivers of this client to adhere to the rules stated above.
